COMMUNITY LIFELINE FOR ANIMAL WELFARE SERVICES

What Is CLAWS?

Claws is committed to providing nutritious dog & cat food & cat litter to senior citizen and low income residents of Kootenai County for their pets.

CLAWS provides healthy nutrition to citizens for their pets who may otherwise not have the ability to do so.



How Much Does It Cost?

While there is no monetary amount required to pay for this program, there is a two hour community service requirement per month per pet to continue in the program.

Who Qualifies For CLAWS?

If you are over 65 years of age or are receiving federal or state financial assistance or otherwise meet the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines, you qualify for the program.

How Long Can I Be In The Program?

Your eligibility in the program will be reviewed every six months. As long as a recipient remains eligible they can continue in the program indefinitely.

Can I Get Food For All My Pets?

Currently CLAWS provides dog food and cat food /litter. As long as the recipient performs two hours of community service for each pet, they can receive food for all of dogs and cats.

How Do I Apply?

1. Fill out the application.
2. Bring or mail the application along with a copy of your drivers license and proof of financial assistance or proof of income to Kootenai Humane Society.
3. Your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of approval.
4. Once approved for the program, you will receive a CLAWS card and community service verification slips. You will also be contacted with distribution location and dates.
