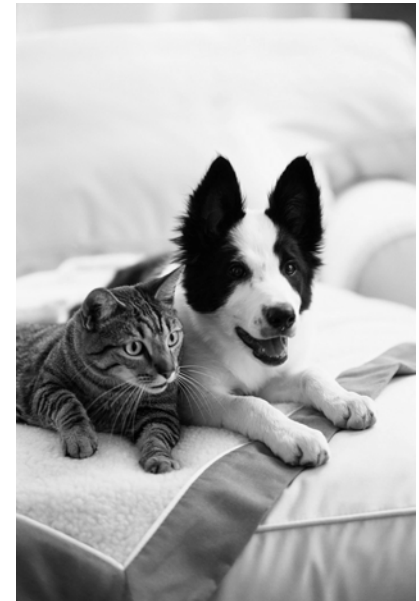

Why Spay & Neuter?

Allowing your pets to breed contributes to the pet overpopulation problem in Kootenai County.

ONE female cat and her offspring can produce over 400,000 unwanted kittens in seven years!

One female dog and her offspring can produce 65,000 unwanted puppies in seven years!



Spaying and neutering your pet is a part of being a responsible owner. Having your pet spayed or neutered will not make it fat, lazy, or less protective. Having your pet sterilized benefits you, your pet, and the community. Most importantly, spaying or neutering your pet reduces the number of homeless animals unnecessarily killed in our community.

What is SPOT?

SPOT is a low-cost dog and cat spay and neuter program for low-income residents of Kootenai County.

The Community SPOT Program was developed by Kootenai Humane Society to address our community's pet overpopulation problem.

What are the benefits?

- Your pet will not produce litters of unwanted puppies or kittens
- Your pet is less likely to roam or run away
- Your pet is less likely to bite
- Your pet is less likely to fight with other animals
- Your pet will be more calm and affectionate
- Your pet will be less likely to spray or mark their territory



Who qualifies?

If you are receiving federal or state financial assistance or otherwise meet the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.

How do I apply?

Pick up an application and fill out one application for each pet you wish to receive services.

Bring your completed application to Kootenai Humane Society
